

Exhibitor Logistics FAQ

1. Where do I ship my booth materials?

You can send the materials straight to the Hotel at the address below. Put your company name and the conference name (**WAMIcon**) on the label.

2. Will there be a method in place to ship company materials back?

Yes. We will have UPS and FED-EX labels onsite as well as a scheduled time for pickup on Tuesday 12/5.

3. Where is my exhibitor space located?

4. When can exhibitors begin setup?

We have the conference area reserved beginning on Sunday 12/3. Exhibitors are welcome to start setting up on Sunday afternoon with the understanding that WAMIcon does not have any method in place to protect items left overnight.

5. Are exhibits open during talks or only during breaks?

The exhibits will be on display for the length of the conference. The breaks and designated exhibitor times will be the busiest time for exhibitors, but registered attendees will be stopping by to request information at all times during the event.

6. Are Exhibitors allowed in Tutorial or talk session?

Exhibitors are given two complimentary passes to the conference including all tutorial and talk sessions.

7. Will the booths have electrical access?

Yes. All booths will have electrical access available for the length of the conference.

8. When should we take down the booth?

The conference sessions are tentatively scheduled until 4 PM on Tuesday 12/5. Exhibitors are invited to keep the booth setup for as long as makes sense after the talks are over. Ultimately the booth takedown will be held at the discretion of the individual companies through Tuesday evening.
