

Instructions for authors of accepted papers (9/29/06)

Final full paper submission guidelines (also applies to papers reviewed and accepted for poster presentation)

- Papers should be no more than 5 pages in double column format.
- Full papers should be submitted through EDAS (<http://www.edas.info/>). Only papers with final camera ready submission will appear in the final agenda and in the conference proceedings.
- Please follow IEEE Computer Society style for submission. Detailed information and style files can be downloaded from <ftp://pubftp.computer.org/Press/Outgoing/proceedings/8.5x11%20-%20Formatting%20files/>
- Only MS Word and PDF (preferred) submission is allowed. Papers without appropriate page formats might not be accepted to be published in the conference proceedings.
- At least one of the authors of the accepted papers **MUST** register (full registration is required) before the submission of the final paper is considered complete. Papers that are not presented at the conference **will not be archived in IEEE Xplore**.
- Authors **must** complete and submit the IEEE Copyright Form before uploading the papers to EDAS web-site (the copyright forms can be faxed directly to Gayla Montgomery 813-974-5250).

If you need a Visa to enter the US please apply for one as early as possible. Visa applications are now subject to a greater degree of scrutiny than in the past.
