Instructions for applying to the Five-year Program (40 6M EGG)

Students will be advised to use the standard application for admission to the graduate program unless there is a specific advantage to entering the Five-year Dual Degree Program.

Students considering the Five Year Program should be aware of the following.

1. Dual degree students **MUST** apply for both their BSEE and their MSEE degrees *at the same time until all graduation requirements are met for both degrees.* NOTE: If a student fulfills all the requirements of their BSEE degree and wants to graduate, they must withdraw from the 5-year program, re-enter the undergraduate program and apply for graduation. They will then have to reapply for the EE Master's program by the standard procedures. *If a student selects to withdraw from the five-year path, the advantage of double counting six credit hours will be lost*
2. Applicants who receive financial aid for their undergraduate program such as Stafford Loans, Pell Grants, Florida Academic Scholars, out of state tuition waivers, etc, may lose their funding when their status changes to 6M. **It is the student's responsibility to ascertain their new financial status.**
3. International students are *encouraged* to use the standard application with the Graduate School and the International Student Services to ensure that a new I/20 is issued and the appropriate VISA obtained. Five Year applications are NOT handled by USF Graduate Admissions.

The Department/College requires the following with your Five-Year Application.

- i) **a copy of your OFFICIAL GRE scores and/or Official TOFEL scores**
- ii) **a copy of you transcript**
- iii) **a statement of purpose which includes the reason you are applying to the five year program**

NOTE: IF your GPA is less than 3.3 or your GRE VQ total is less than 1000, you may be denied so attach at least one letter of recommendation from a faculty member in the Department to which you are applying.
